
HEALTH – SAFETY – ENVIRONMENT (HSE)

APPENDIX TO THE TRANSPORT ORDER

1. OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH, SAFETY AND FIRE PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor (Carrier), while performing transportation services on behalf of HRT Intertrans Kft. (the Client), shall comply with all applicable occupational health and safety, occupational health, and fire protection legislation relating to transport activities, as well as all valid regulations governing road traffic, loading, and warehouse operations.

The Contractor undertakes to ensure that:

- its drivers hold the required driving licences, professional qualifications, and valid medical fitness certificates necessary for the performance of their duties;
- all drivers receive regular occupational health and safety and fire protection training, including training on loading, load securing, and the handling of hazardous materials where applicable;
- all vehicles and equipment are operated in accordance with the applicable technical and safety requirements;
- its drivers use the personal protective equipment (PPE) required for the performance of their duties (e.g. high-visibility vest, safety footwear, protective gloves, and safety helmet where required);
- in the event of a fire or accident, drivers are familiar with the use of the fire extinguisher, emergency warning equipment, and first-aid kit carried in the vehicle.

2. ENVIRONMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall fully comply with all applicable environmental protection and water resource protection legislation while performing transportation services.

The Contractor undertakes to:

- operate its vehicles in accordance with environmentally responsible driving principles (e.g. minimizing engine idling, maintaining optimum speed, and applying eco-driving techniques);
- give preference to vehicles with lower emissions and higher energy efficiency whenever possible;
- prevent environmental pollution during loading and transportation (e.g. by preventing the leakage of hazardous substances and ensuring proper waste handling);
- collect and transfer any waste generated during its activities (such as pallets, plastic film, and packaging materials) for treatment in accordance with applicable legal requirements;
- ensure that its activities do not adversely affect the environmental conditions at the Client's premises.

3. OTHER REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall conduct its activities in a manner consistent with the Integrated Management System Policy of HRT Intertrans Kft. and in compliance with the professional and ethical standards expected by the Client.

In particular, the Contractor shall ensure that:

- its drivers act courteously and professionally when visiting the Client's customers and business partners;
- drivers comply with all site rules and loading procedures;
- any extraordinary event (including accidents, property damage, environmental pollution, or traffic incidents) is reported to the Client without delay.
